













OVERVIEW

This safari package will give you the exciting opportunity to visit the most beautiful parks in northern Tanzania. You'll visit the endless plains of Serengeti National Park, where you will be able to see all the major safari animals in great numbers. You will also visit Lake Manyara, which is famous for a huge population of elephants, as well as Ngorongoro Crater, which is locally known as the "garden of animals," where there is a big chance to spot the big five all in one day.

All of our African wildlife safaris specifically include the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and the world-famous Ngorongoro Crater. This specific Africa safari and travel itinerary has been designed for visitors with more time on hand for longer safari tours.

This unforgettable Africa safari package will take you to Lake Manyara National Park, one of Tanzania's most dramatically located wildlife areas, consisting of a shallow but huge soda lake located at the foot of the Great Rift Valley's western escarpment. The park's size makes it perfect for a one-day game drive and is notably famous for its tree-climbing lions. This safari will also take you to Serengeti National Park, a massive wilderness of 14,500 square km, where every day brings a new landscape and a new adventure. It will also take you to the Ngorongoro Crater and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area in Tanzania, featuring one of the highest concentrations of game and arguably the densest population of predators and carnivores in Africa. Here you will witness an amazing spectacle of African wildlife – inside a self-contained world teeming with animals.

Detailed Itinerary

Day 1: Kilimanjaro International Airport to Moshi

Upon your arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport (JRO), a Nature Horizons team member will be waiting to greet you. We will transfer you to your hotel accommodation for your first night, where you will meet your safari guide that you will be with for the remainder of your tour. Once you are settled in your hotel, you will receive a briefing on our tour. You can now relax at your hotel. Your trek to the roof of Africa starts tomorrow! As always, if you need anything or would like to head out into town, your guide will be there to assist you 24/7.

Welcome to Africa!

Drive: 45 minutes to one hour

Day 2: Arusha/Moshi to Lake Manyara National Park

You will be picked up from your hotel in Arusha at 8:30 AM and driven to Lake Manyara National Park. Enjoy a full-day game drive with a picnic lunch. Lake Manyara is a shallow, alkaline lake at the base of the Western Rift Valley escarpment. The park entrance leads to a beautiful groundwater forest. This park is known for its large elephant population. The lions are present but not seen that easily. The forest patch is home to troops of olive baboons and blue monkeys. Buffalo, giraffe, and several antelope species are easily encountered on a drive.

Main destination: Lake Manyara National Park

Meals & drinks: Lunch and dinner

Drinking water (Other drinks not included)

Day 3: Lake Manyara to Serengeti National Park

After breakfast, we head toward the Serengeti National Park via the beautiful high lying farmland of Karatu and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Leaving the highlands behind, we descend into the heart of wild Africa – the Serengeti National Park – with its endless plains rolling into the distance as far as the eye can see. We will then head to the central park area, known as the Seronera area, one of the richest wildlife habitats in the park, featuring the Seronera River, which provides a valuable water source to this area and attracts wildlife well representative of most of the Serengeti's species. We arrive in time for lunch and enjoy an afternoon game drive in the Serengeti National Park.

Main destination: Serengeti National Park

Meals & drinks: All meals included

Drinking water (Other drinks not included)

Day 4: Serengeti to Ngorongoro Conservation Area

Enjoy an early breakfast and meet your guide to have a last morning game drive in Serengeti National Park then depart to the Ngorongoro Conservation area with an en-route game drive and picnic lunch. Ngorongoro is a special conservation area and not a national park. The whole area is managed for both animals and local Maasai people who graze their cattle alongside the indigenous wildlife.

Main destination: Ngorongoro

Day 5: Crater tour (5 hours' game drive) and to Arusha/Moshi





After breakfast, descend into the crater and enjoy a 5-hour game drive in the crater. The Ngorongoro Crater is one of the most densely crowded African wildlife areas in the world and is home to an estimated 30,000 animals, including some of Tanzania's last remaining black rhino.

Supported by a year-round water supply and vegetation, the crater supports a wide variety of animals, including herds of wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, eland, warthog, hippo, and giant African elephants. Another big draw card to this picturesque national park is its huge population of predators, including lions, hyenas, jackals, cheetahs, and the ever-elusive leopard. We will enjoy a picnic lunch on the crater floor.

In the late afternoon, we will drive back to Arusha and drop off at your hotel. The rest of the day is yours to relax.
